Ones to watch

The Sainsbury's Anniversary Games will welcome 10 Olympic Champions and seven Paralympic Champions back to London, here are just a few names to watch out for:

Witness Olympic Champion **Sally Pearson** take on world champion **Brianna Rollins** and world bronze medallist from Britain, **Tiffany Porter** in the women's 100m hurdles.

In the women's 100m, the stellar line-up includes the world leader over 100m this year, **Michelle-Lee Ahye**; Olympic 100m champion **Shelly-Ann Fraser-Pryce**, Olympic 200m Champion **Allyson Felix** and Olympic 4x100m relay gold medallist, **Carmelita Jeter**.

The men's 110m hurdles is an equally impressive field including Olympic Champion and world record holder, **Aries Merritt**, alongside fellow Americans, world 110m hurdles champion, **David Oliver** and world silver medallist, **Ryan Wilson**.

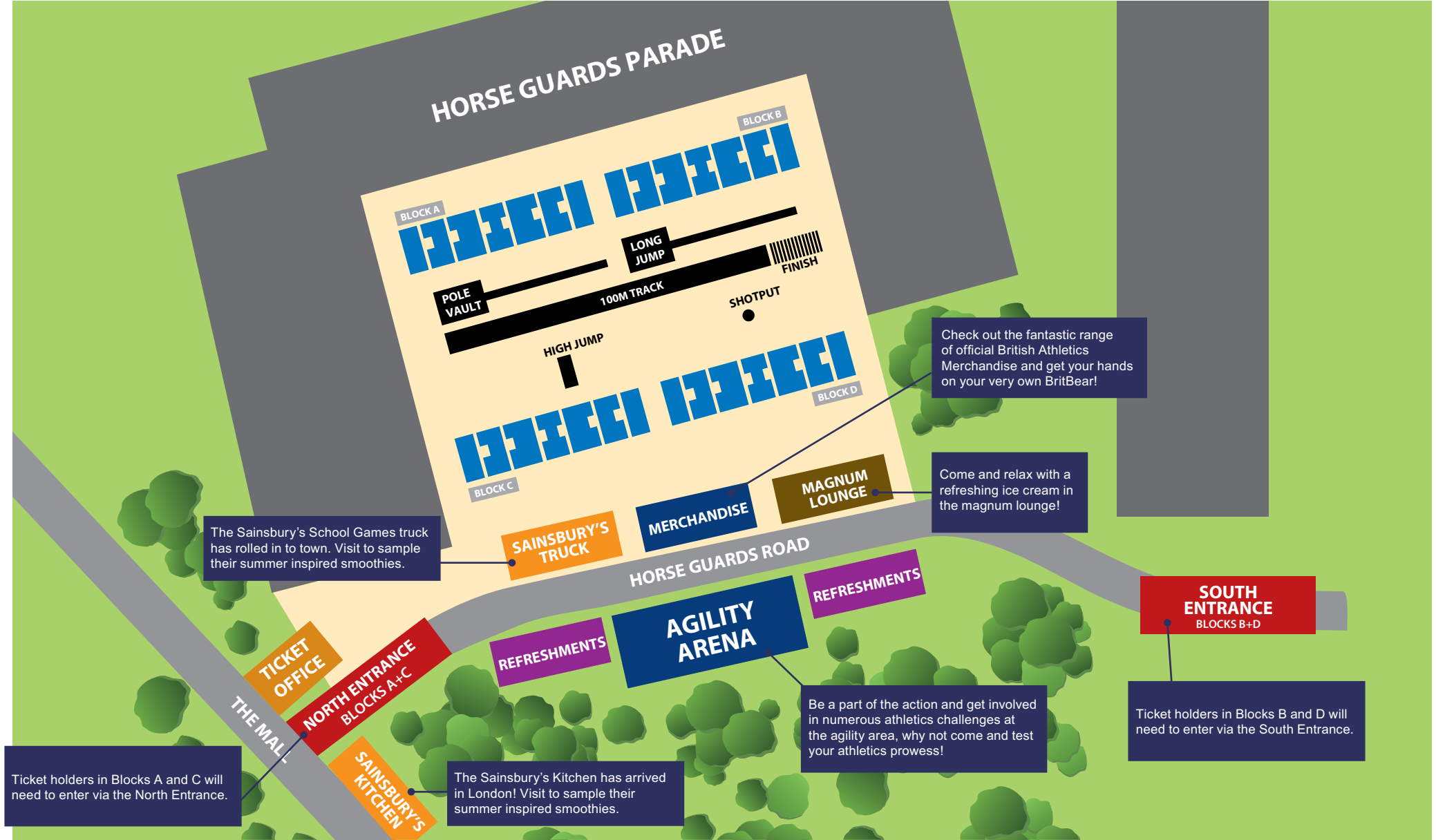
