Travelling by Road

By Car

Take the A6178 Attercliffe Common, and follow the tourist information signs for the English Institute of Sport. Turn into Coleridge Road, then access Don Valley Bowl through the gated entrance.

Car Parking

Car parking will be available within the Don Valley bowl on grassland; accessible from Coleridge road. There will be a small charge, please follow the relevant road signage and assistance provided by stewards. Other Car Parks directly surrounding the EIS are for Car Park Pass Holders only.

Travelling by Bus

A large number of bus routes serve the Institute from the bus station / Sheffield Passenger Interchange and depart every 10 minutes. The number 69 stops outside EIS Sheffield and the 52 stops in Attercliffe, just a short walk away.

Travelling by Tram

The Supertram service runs from easily identifiable stops through Sheffield city centre, and at Sheffield rail Station. The 'yellow' tram route will take you to the arena/Don Valley Stadium stop which is two minutes' walk from EIS.

Six park and ride sites are served by the Supertram system. These are located at Meadowhall, Valley Centertainment, Halfway, Parkway Central, Malin Bridge and Middlewood.


Ones to watch

Some of the biggest names in British athletics will once again feature at the Sainsbury's Indoor British Championships in Sheffield this weekend, with places on the GB& NI team for March's European Indoor Championships in Prague up for grabs.

Heptathlon star Katarina Johnson-Thompson will compete in both the long jump and high jump, where she will face new British record holder Isobel Pooley.

In the sprints, multiple British champion Dwain Chambers will look to improve on his second place from last year in the 60m and Dina Asher-Smith will be one of the favourites in a red hot women's 60m race.

Another event to look out for will be the women's 3000m where Jessica Judd will go head to head with Hannah England amongst others.
